
PART 1: GEOGRAPHY

- b) Which 'top 10' country is estimated to have the largest percentage increase in population between 2015 and 2100 [1]
- c) Give two reasons why China's population is estimated to fall between 2015 and 2100 [2]
- d) Europe's population continues to age significantly. Describe and explain three implications of Europe's population getting older? [6]

Question 2

Extended writing task. Choose **one** of the questions below and write a response.

"Earthquakes in poor countries always cause more damage and loss of human life than earthquakes in rich countries." To what extent do you agree with this statement? [10]

"Human causes are more responsible for flooding than physical causes." To what extent do you agree with this statement? [10]

"The benefits of large scale urban development(s) outweigh the disadvantages." To what extent do you agree with this statement? [10]

"The benefits of large scale transport project(s) outweigh the disadvantages." To what extent do you agree with this statement? [10]
