## PART 1: GEOGRAPHY

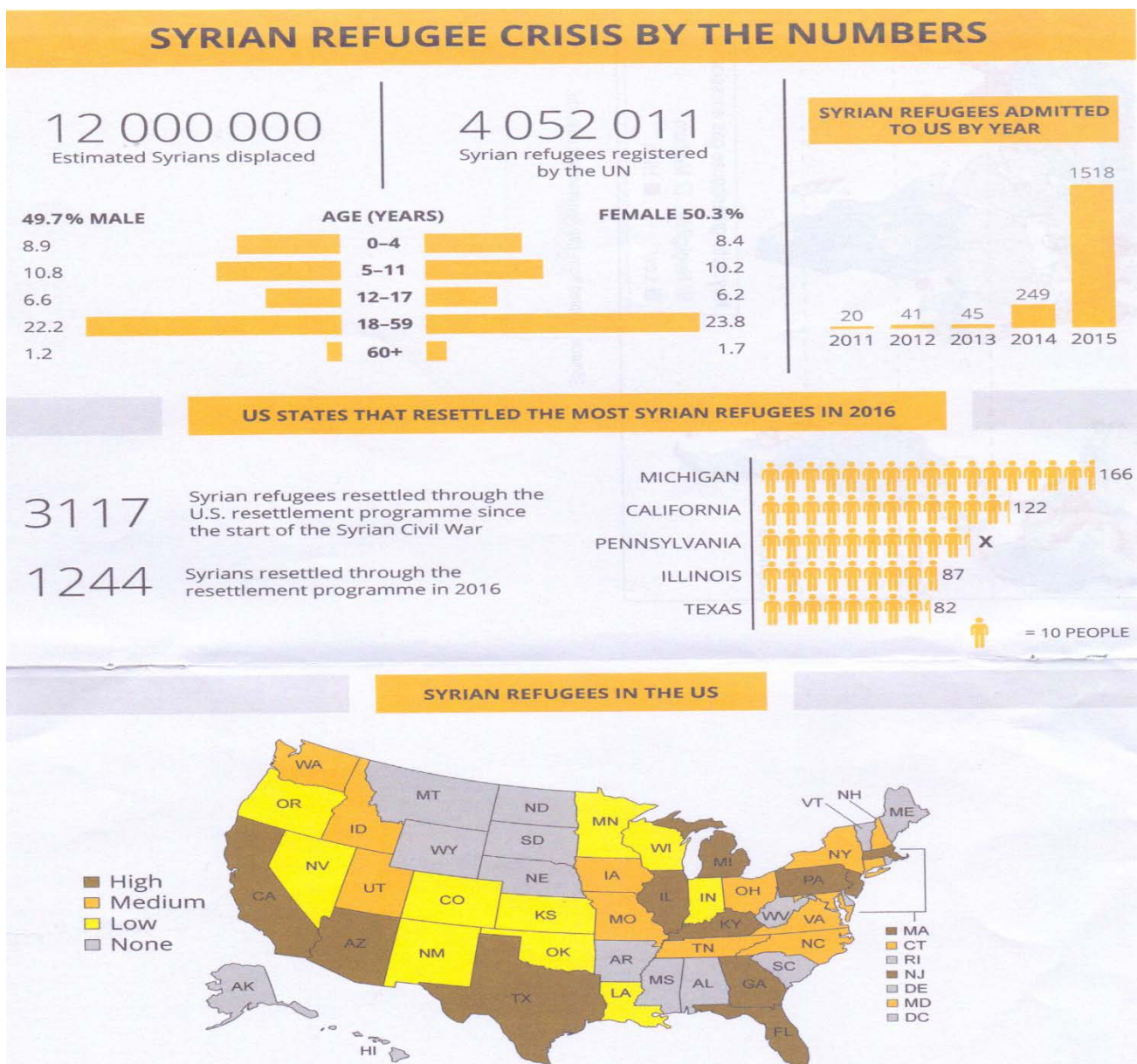

### Question 1

Infographic analysis:

The infographic shows Syrian refugees in the US. Use the infographic to answer the questions that follow it:



- a) Estimate the number of Syrian refugees that have settled in Pennsylvania (labelled X). [1mark]
- b) Determine the increase in the number of Syrian refugees admitted to the US between 2013 and 2014. [1 mark]
- c) Using evidence from the population pyramid **only**, describe **one** possible challenge faced by the US government in resettling Syrian refugees. [2 marks]
- d) International migration is the movement of persons away from their place of usual residence and across an international border to a country of which they are not nationals. Explain three impacts of migration on the country of origin (i.e. place of usual residence)? [6 marks]

## Question 2

Extended writing task:

Choose **ONE** of the questions below and write a structured response (refer to appropriate examples in your response).

**Either**

- 1 “A country with an ageing population faces only problems in the future.” To what extent do you agree with this statement? [10 marks]

**Or**

- 2 “Volcanic eruptions in low income countries inevitably pose a greater hazard for people than volcanic eruptions in high income countries.” To what extent do you agree with this statement? [10 marks]

**Or**

- 3 “Environmental problems are the biggest challenge to cities coping with more people.” To what extent do you agree with this statement? [10 marks]

3. Explain how demands for representation have resulted in change in any society, country or group of people you have studied. [15 marks]

4. 'Desires for monetary gain are the main cause of wars.' How far do you agree with this statement? Use any examples you would like to support your answer. [15 marks]
