#### 1. Old Testament – The Creation

- a) What was the fall? [2 marks]
- b) In Genesis 3, God punishes Adam and Eve for eating fruit from the Tree of Knowledge. Describe how he punishes them and explain why he chooses to punish them in this way. [5 marks]
- c) Who was the most and least responsible for the Original Sin? Explain your response by giving specific reasons to support you. [8 marks]

- a) What is atonement? [2 marks]
- b) Describe why some Christians believe that it was necessary for Jesus to die. [5 marks]
- c) According to the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus called out whilst on the cross "My God, my God why have you forsaken me?" Explain what he could have meant by this. [8 marks]
